



# 2017-2018 School Supply List

**Please note:**

- Students need to have all the items listed on the first day of school.
- Parents will need to replace these items when they are used at the request of the teacher.

## ELC 3 & ELC 4

**Personal Items: (These MUST be labeled with student's name)**

- 2 Thick plastic carrying folders (2cm width)
- 1 drawing notebooks (white paper 48 pages without lines)
- 1 folder with 100 plastic sleeves
- Plastic water bottle with lid (NO baby bottles or sippy cups)
- 1 regular sized back pack that fits the plastic folder
- 1 plastic paint apron
- Change of uniform clothes **in a labeled bag** in case of an accident. (School uniform shirt, pants or shorts, socks, underclothes, shoes). These clothes will be left at school.
- 1 small blanket or towel for nap time (*for full-day students*).
- 1 Toothbrush w/ **cover** & toothpaste (*for full-day students*)

**Community (Shared) Supplies:** (no labels necessary)

- 2 packs of Crayons (triangle shaped preferred)
- 2 packs of Markers (Thick ones with thin tip)
- 3 packages of Wet Wipes

## ELC 4

**All of the above list plus these items**

- 1 pair of rounded (safety) scissors (labeled with name)
- 2 jumbo triangle pencils (sharpened), 1 eraser
- 2 packs of jumbo colored pencils

## Kindergarten

**Personal Items: (These MUST be labeled with student's name)**

- 2 Thick plastic carrying folders (2cm width)
- 2 thick dividers (~3cm with about 6 sections)
- 2 small spiral notebooks
- 1 regular sized backpack
- 1 paint apron
- Plastic water bottle with lid (No sippy cups)
- 1 small blanket or towel for nap time. This should be small enough to fit into a shoe box.
- Toothbrush with cover
- Change of uniform clothes **in a labeled bag** in case of an accident. (School uniform shirt, pants or shorts, socks,

## Kindergarten (continued)

**Kindergarten Community Supplies:** (no labels necessary)

- 2 tubes of toothpaste
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 packs of Crayons (with paper around them)
- 2 packs of colored pencils
- 1 pack of sharpened pencils
- 1 pack of Wet Wipes
- 4 glue sticks
- 3 large erasers

## 1st & 2nd Grades

- 1 Thick plastic carrying folders (2cm width)
- 1 small hardcover journal notebook (100 pages)
- 1 spiral notebooks (easy tear-out pages)
- 1 plastic water bottle with lid
- 1 pair of scissors
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 set of thin markers
- 10 pencils, 1 Pencil case
- 3 large erasers
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 ruler (inch/cm preferred)

## 3rd, 4th, & 5th Grades

- 3 thin transparent folders
- 2 thick divider (~3 cm, with about 6 sections)
- 2 small hardcover journal notebooks (100 pages)
- 4 spiral notebooks (96-100 pages)
- 1 graph paper notebook (5 mm squares)
- 1 drawing notebook
- 10 pencils, 3 erasers, 1 pencil case
- 1 large, old shirt for painting
- 1 memory stick
- 1 set of headphones
- Water bottle
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 pens (1 black and 1 blue)
- 1 ruler (inch/cm preferred), 1 protractor

## 6th, 7th & 8th Grades

- 4-6 medium-large A4 spiral notebooks
- 2 thin spiral notebooks (96-100 pages)
- 4 black or blue pens
- 5 pencils (mechanical preferred)
- extra lead for mechanical pencils or pencil sharpener
- 3 erasers, 1 highlighter, 1 scissors
- 1 small to medium pencil case
- 6 small folders or 1 divider (with at least 6 divided sections)
- Water bottle
- 1 set of small durable headphones
- 1 scientific calculator (with parenthesis)
- Protractor, compass, ruler (inch/cm preferred)
- 1 graph paper notebook (or package) with small grid lines (required for all math classes)
- **Other supplies may be required as per class syllabus**

## 9th – 12th Grades

- 4-6 medium-large spiral A4 notebooks depending on syllabus
- Mechanical pencils & extra lead
- Pens, highlighters, erasers
- Water bottle
- Protractor and compass
- 1 scientific calculator (includes Trig functions (sin, cos, tan) and parenthesis) **OR** 1 graphing calculator brand TI-83 (required for Algebra II & Advanced Math)
- 1 set of small durable headphones
- **Other supplies as per syllabus**
